This exciting and lively public space, in the heart of the downtown core, is one of the busiest intersections in Canada with **up to**150,000 pedestrians passing by daily.

This popular tourist spot draws in local residents and visitors from near and far with its various cultural and commercial events. The unique food vendors, live music, dancing fountains, and great allure of the downtown core attracts a crowd that highlights the diversity and community in Toronto.



SANKOFA SQUARE

On December 14, 2023, the City of Toronto announced that **Toronto City Council adopted a motion to change the name of Yonge- Dundas Square to Sankofa Square**.

The Yonge-Dundas Square Board of Management and staff are mapping out next steps and timing related to the renaming.

The Square will continue to operate under the name of Yonge-Dundas Square until change over details and a date are confirmed.

LOCATION BENEFITS

Yonge-Dundas Square is a prime event location in downtown Toronto with more than 110,000 residents and 500,000 workers within a 10-minute walk of the Square, plus 50 million visitors each year.

Events hosted at the Square **gain exposure to a diverse audience** from nearby attractions and institutions, including the Eaton Centre, Little Canada, Ed Mirvish Theatre, Massey Hall, Toronto Metropolitan University, Cineplex Yonge-Dundas, and the onsite City Sightseeing Tours bus stop.

Visitors and event attendees have the added **convenience and accessibility** with the Dundas TTC subway station onsite, nearby streetcar and bus stops, and underground parking and washroom facilities located just below the Square.



VENUE FEATURES



A 36 by 39-foot permanent, covered main stage with concert sound and lighting systems with a catwalk extension is available on request.

Available from May to September



Two 8' by 12' vertical and three 20' by 10' horizontal screens are strategically placed throughout the Square. They serve to enhance visibility and promote your event.



Accessible via P1 Parking Level with a unique code per event.

Includes a mini fridge, microwave, and kettle.



Barricades, 10 x 10 tents, tent weights, tables, chairs, and cable mats. YDS also provides all vendors with electrical connections and weather-grade electrical cord



In addition to our 24/7 security guards, extra event security guards will be assigned to each event to fit your event's needs and enhance the safety of staff and attendees. Smart Serve guards are available for events with a beer garden.

OPERATIONS TEAM

The YDS Operations team oversees site maintenance and YDS equipment set up to assist in a smooth set-up and tear-down. The operations team also oversees garbage maintenance during the event to ensure a clean experience for event attendees.


AV PRODUCTION TEAM


